Packaging modifications	
What needs to be updated on the primary packaging ?	We will apply a QR code on our primary packaging in the future, which refers to Kaufland as the manufacturer . We will contact you regarding the implementation in due course. We will still add the QR code to ongoing WAVE jobs (up to and including status 6). For all layouts completed in WAVE but not yet printed (status 7), we ask you to coordinate the further procedure with your responsible Kaufland WAVE processor to determine whether another layout revision or immediate printing makes more sense in these cases.
What needs to be adapted on the secondary packaging (trays) ?	You are responsible for applying the QR code to the trays. This QR code will be provided to you by Kaufland shortly and should be applied to the trays as quickly as possible without destroying packaging material (ongoing jobs in WAVE are excluded).
What are the implementation guidelines for applying the QR code and the type, batch or serial number to the trays?	Placement: on the bottom or side of the tray 1. Application on the label: If you are already applying a label anyway, you can use it for the markings. 2. Integration into the print design: The QR code can be integrated into the existing print design starting from the next reprint (without additional color). You arrange this application independently in coordination with your repro/printing company.

	Color: Scannability must be ensured, pay attention to sufficient contrast. 3. In-line printing: If you print your trays during the production process, you can apply the QR code during the production process.. Applications on the front are excluded for all 3 variants. . Size: min. 12mm x 12mm max. 20mm x 20mm + necessary clear zone of 2mm all around + type, batch or serial number of the supplier The valid minimum line thicknesses must be observed.
Transition Periods and Stock Management	
Until when will Kaufland accept goods without or with not yet adapted manufacturer details?	We accept existing stock as usual (risk-based approach) and do not reject any goods . This allows us to prevent the ecologically and economically harmful destruction of goods. .
Responsibilities	
Who is responsible for creating and maintaining the data for the QR code ?	As part of the packaging adaptation, you will receive the QR code from Kaufland. You do not generate this yourself. Kaufland is liable for the accuracy of the information stored behind the QR code.
